Re: Catlin Parade of Lights

Dear Community Member:

The Catlin Parade of Lights Committee, along with the support of the Village of Catlin will be presenting their 5th Annual Christmas Parade this year. The parade will be Sunday, November 29, from 6-7 PM. Due to social distancing requirements and in order to keep everyone safe, we will be having a "progressive parade" where families will be the actual parade and stop at different locations for an evening of lights, treats, and Christmas Spirit! In order to keep Santa healthy and able to complete his trip around the world to all children on Christmas Eve, you will be required to stay in your vehicle at all times. No walkers will be allowed. Residents should line up and follow the caravan starting on Westwood Dr.

Stop 1: The lighted floats will be arranged in and around the Catlin Park on Vermilion St. Families will drive around the park (see attached map).

Stop 2: In every effort to keep Santa safe so he will reach every house on Christmas Eve, no pictures will be taken, and all families will remain in their cars. Santa and his elves will be waiting in front of our beautiful Community Christmas Tree to personally collect letters to Santa from all the children and give each child a treat!

Stop 3: In front of the Village Hall Community Room entrance, there will be to-go cups of hot cocoa delivered to each car by the amazing team from the Catlin Bank!

Stop 4: The fourth and final stop will be in front of High on the Hog restaurant where High on the Hog and Encore Catering have teamed up to provide to-go cups of chili that will be delivered to your car!

For the second year, there will be a Christmas Tree decorating contest sponsored by Floral-n-Flair! The small Christmas trees that line S. Sandusky within the business district will be eligible for businesses or service clubs to decorate for prize money. First place -\$75, second place-\$50, third place-\$25. Each organization will need to contact Cheri Welsh at Floral-n-Flair or call 427-5888. Cheri will provide each organization with entry form, lights, and requirements for each tree. This is an opportunity for your organization to help light up our Village, show your Christmas spirit and earn cash for your club.

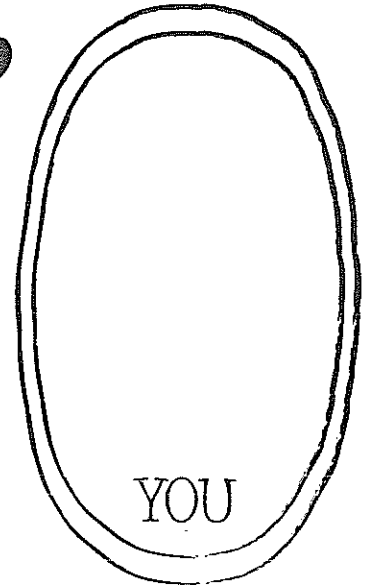
