Kevin asked for clarification on payments made to Homefield Energy. Shelley stated this was the company that currently had the energy contract with the Village. It was previously Constellation NewEnergy and now it is Homefield Energy. Upon reading of said bills, a motion was made by Jim, seconded by Kevin that the Treasurer pay said bills.

Mayor Robinson informed the board that Ameren had reached out to him with an offer to change all the light fixtures in the Village Hall and supply eighty new light bulbs for \$129. Kevin stated that these would be the T5 bulbs and that it could save the Village and Township on the energy bills. Mayor Robinson stated that Ameren was supposed to send a representative to the meeting but no one was there from Ameren.

Matt Johnson of Fehr Graham addressed the board regarding the water main grant. He stated that the contract between the Village and Fehr Graham is with the Village attorney and after discussion with Shelley, an amendment to the original contract was done to exclude Fehr Graham from administering the grant but if the Board felt that Shelley had too much to do, it could be added at any point during the process.

### Commissioner Kirk:

- Christmas decorations are down.
- Carl and Kevin gave details on a new spreader for the truck. There are two options, a nine inch spreader and a six inch spreader, both are stainless steel. The nine inch spreader is \$5,000 installed and takes six weeks to get in once ordered, the six inch spreader is \$4,000 installed and is currently in stock. Kevin stated that the Village could save time and money with the new spreader. The Township uses a nine inch spreader but that is due to the higher speed that they are at during spreading, whereas the Village would be able to use the six inch spreader because within the Village, we are at a lower speed. Kevin recommendation was to purchase the six in spreader this year or have it added to the budget for next year. Butch asked if we could get by with what we currently have. Kevin stated that we could but would use more salt and sand if we did. Kevin said he would gather additional information and bring it to the next board meeting.

## Commissioner Reddy:

- The sewer was plugged on the south end of town last week but the water department fixed it the same day it was discovered.
- Pump station was completed by Wade Anderson. Mayor Robinson also stated that Wade did the trim on the building that was not in the bid at no cost to the Village.

Butch asked Kevin if we had looked any more into the mobile lights for the water department. Kevin stated that when it was looked into last year, it was \$10,000. Kevin stated he would look into it again to see if we could find something that was reasonable in price and had the generator with enough power to run the lift station, if needed.

Cash stated that the expedition was in an accident the night before but no one was hurt. Kevin stated that the county road, Catlin-Homer Road was not salted or plowed again. Mayor Robinson instructed Shelley to write them another letter regarding the lack of proper safety measures taken by the County on the Catlin-Homer Road.
