Aaron asked for clarification on General check #184025 to Simmons Tree Service. Shelley stated this was for trees on Mapleleaf and a removal of a stump on Webster. Larry Owen addressed the board regarding the Balloons Over Vermilion. Larry stated that a group of Vermilion County residents were trying to bring back a smaller version of the Balloon Classic. The group would like to showcase all of Vermilion County, not just Danville. The event would take place at the airport in Danville on July 15<sup>th</sup> and 16<sup>th</sup>. A local event could be held in Catlin prior to that weekend. Larry stated that it would cost \$1,500.00 for the balloon to

come and be hosted within Catlin. Larry would like to see Catlin plan an event around the balloon. Larry stated that he had spoken with Jeff Fauver from the Catlin Bank and he would be willing to pay a third of the cost as a sponsor for the event. Larry stated that the Village or the organization that host the event could sell raffle tickets for two hot air balloon rides for the event at Balloons Over Vermilion. The weekend of the Strawberry Festival was discussed but Larry stated the first weekend in June may be too early. Tad Beddow suggested the weekend of the Cobra Classic. Mayor Schmink directed Shelley to inquire to different organization about creating an event.

Matt Johnson asked for the change order on the water main project to be tabled until the next meeting after a substantial walk-thru was completed by himself and a commissioner. Fred stated he could do any Tuesday or Thursday that worked for Matt. Jim stated he would also like to be on the walk-thru. Matt stated he would look at his calendar and contact Shelley with available dates.

Matt Johnson stated that he had spoken to Kevin Kirk regarding the Farrar Street repair and a pay request for Cross Construction would be at the next meeting.

Mayor Schmink stated that Scott Church had asked if the board would be willing to place a power supply large enough for the Annual Fish Fry at the Village Hall next to the air conditioners on the East side of the building. Mayor Schmink stated he would ask Scott to come to an upcoming board meeting to explain exactly what they are wanting.
