Mayor Schmink explained that he had sent a letter to Norfolk Southern regarding the numerous and extended blockings of the railroad crossings. Mayor Schmink asked David Harrold to explain the process the police department follows when all three railroad crossings are blocked. Officer Harrold explained that the police will call Decatur and explain the problem and he has even driven out to speak with the conductor. Officer Harrold suggested that we ask a representative from Norfolk Southern to come to our meeting and get resolution. Harrold stated that it is not if an accident happens that emergency workers can't get to the scene, it is when an accident happens. The Illinois Commerce Commssion (ICC) is over the railroad and bringing

them in to help us might be a good option. Aaron stated that he knows an ICC police officer and he would get in contact with him to see what we could do.

Tom Baird explained some of the electrical work that needed to be done in order to make the lighting of the Annual Christmas tree easier. Tom stated he would contact Ameren and write up a bid for the work and return it to the board.

- Water is hooked up at the Splash Park. Aaron is meeting with Seth Smoot tomorrow to go over the concrete and bench lay out. Kevin stated that there was around ninety feet of concrete to pour and people have volunteered to help set forms and pour the concrete.

Commissioner Kirk:

- The Street Department has started repairs on the streets from the winter wear and tear.
- Some areas of town have been seeded and a list of summer projects is being made that includes some alley work.
- The Village is low on rock and sand and some will have to be purchased. Additional black dirt will need to also be purchased for the park. Jim suggested Kevin speak with TJ Ribbe due to the expansion behind Rich's Restaurant. Kevin stated that Ribbe has already been very generous with his help for the Splash Park and that was a great idea and he would contact him tomorrow.

Commissioner Reddy:

- Fred thanked Mr. and Mrs. Brown for attending the meeting and their patience during the water main extension project on South Paris. Mr. Brown stated that he was not happy with how Dan Long from Cross Construction behaved but that our Village Mayor did a wonderful job at the meeting they had earlier that day.
- Fred stated that Tim was working on a valve at the wastewater plant.
- Fred stated that he believed the Board should approve \$15.00 increase to the monthly water and sewer bills. Mayor Schmink stated that the Village has to raise the rates but we only want to do it one time. Aaron pointed out that the current budget that was just approved had \$42,000 coming out of savings and no matter what the Board decides to do, the residents of Catlin need to be informed that this is coming. Kevin suggested that the board look over all the documents that the engineers have provided and be ready to discuss rate increases at the next meeting.
- Fred also stated that a resident outside of town asked for the water rate for those on Village water but not within the Village limits be looked into, stating that paying twice the rate is unfair. Mayor Schmink stated that the out of limit rate was per ordinance and shouldn't be changed.
