Dave Dutton, Lion's Club member addressed the board regarding the upcoming Annual Fish Fry. Matt Johnson, engineer from Fehr Graham recapped the outcome of the Paris and Merrill St. water main project. Matt stated that twenty-five homes had new hook ups and wireless meters, 1500 feet of new water main has been installed, three new fire hydrants, repaving of a block of Farrar Street, and the project came in under budget by \$70,000.00. At this time, Matt requested the board approve the last change order for a reduction in cost of \$5,541.31 and approve the final pay request from Cross Construction of \$77,585.75.
