Mayor Schmink explained that there was interest in updating Ordinance 92 to include grass clippings being blown into the street or sidewalk to be a nuisance. Kevin stated that the Street Department spends hours cleaning out the catch basins due to grass clippings. Wanda stated that Ridgefarm had just passed this ordinance and Mayor Schmink stated Oakwood had also adopted this ordinance. Mayor Schmink instructed the Village Clerk to obtain a copy of both Ridgefarm and Oakwood's ordinance for review for the next meeting.

Shelley explained State Statute 65 ILCS 5/11-31-1-E in regards to the property at 101-103 S. Sandusky. Nancy Dolan stated that their insurance company will not give them a copy of their engineering report but the Council was welcome to call Pekin Insurance and their agent would explain the report to them. Nancy further stated that they were requesting twelve-month extension and their plans were to remove the buildings but there is quite a bit of valuable items and materials inside the buildings that they would like to remove. Mayor Schmink asked if the Village engineer could inspect the building. Terry and Nancy Dolan stated that they could come and inspect the building at any time. Mayor Schmink stated that if the building is not structurally sound, the Council wouldn't be able to wait twelve months.
