- Kevin stated the street department was preparing equipment for the upcoming Spring. Salt and sand is still in good shape.
- Kevin has been in contact with two contractors to get some bids on replacing some asphalt where there have been water and wastewater repairs done that have damaged the streets.
- Carl stated that the Village Clerk was looking into having the wind shield on the dump truck replaced. The Clerk stated the Village's insurance company would cover repairs to a wind shield at a hundred percent, with no deductible. To have the wind shield replaced, was also covered but the \$500.00 deductible applied. A price was received from Owens Auto Glass to have it replaced for \$170.00, so the replacement would not be turned into insurance.

Commissioner Reddy:

- Fred reported on the condition of the wastewater plant. Three pumps were plugged due to what the engineers called "First flush" from the first rain. Two of the pumps, Tim was able to get back working.
- Fred informed the board that no action would be taken on Ordinance 743, regarding the debt ordinance for the wastewater plant tonight, as the engineers directed the board to wait until fiscal year 2017-2018 audit is complete.
