#### Commissioner Cummings:

- Jerry informed the board that the Police Department had received bids from Best Buy for a new computer and this would be purchased out of the equipment purchase line item in the current budget.
- Ameren was out to install a new meter on the Village Hall and said that one of the air conditioning units at the Hall is a three-phase. They suggested we look into replacing this unit. Wanda stated that she would have Denis come and look at the unit.

- Matt Johnson informed the board that one of the wastewater pumps did fail or got plugged during the recent rains. The dri-prime pump that was purchased with the County was able to step in and pump 2000 gallons per minute. Matt thanked Tim and his crew for all their hard work on keeping water out of the residents' basements.
- Matt stated that the pumps are getting rebuilt but don't want to do this every time it rains. The design phase is sixty-percent complete and there are more problems that have been found. A study session was suggested to dig deeper into the wastewater plant rebuild.
