Commissioner Kirk:

- Kevin asked Tim McFadden to give an update on the wastewater plant progress. Tim stated that there are two add-ons that will be added to the project to add more electrical outlets and four more ash trees have to be removed. Kevin stated that an omission in the engineering had no 110 outlets to service the exterior of the plant. Once a price comes in on the cost of the change order, this will be discussed with the engineers. Mayor Schmink asked if the plant was still on schedule. Kevin stated it was hard to say if it is on schedule, but the contractors claim to be ahead of schedule.
- Kevin stated that new meters were on hand and those should be getting installed.


Mayor Schmink:

- Mayor Schmink asked Shelley to explain the Farmer's Market. Shelley stated that herself and Greg Learnard were working together to bring a Farmer's Market to Catlin. The Farmer's Market would take place each Thursday from 4 PM to 6 PM starting the week before Memorial Day and running through Labor Day. Shelley stated they were in the process of trying to find vendors and asked David Biggerstaff to add this to the article in the Sidell Reporter.
- Mayor Schmink asked to postpone the discussion on the sign ordinance memo that was received from the Village Attorney as he would like more time to review the contents.

Chief Beddow:

Bill Ingram asked if he could speak to the board. Mayor Schmink stated that the public expression portion of the meeting has passed but he would allow him to go ahead and speak. Bill stated he was contacted by Terry Dolan and Terry asked him to put a sign up on his property. Bill then handed out pocket US Constitution pamphlets to the board and members of the audience. Bill stated that his sign is not a political sign and is legal and there is no basis for him to have to take it down. Bill further stated that he would not take the sign down for any reason and he would fight the ticket that Terry Dolan received, and the Village has bigger problem to worry about than a sign and that the board is just wasting money trying to fight him.
