Commissioner Schmit:

- Wanda informed the board that Powell Fencing will be starting work this week and will be removing the old fencing and existing poles and they should be done by the end of the week.

Commissioner Cummings:

- Jerry stated that they are getting ready to start on the salt barn within the next week. Work will be done to rebuild it inside and out.

Commissioner Kirk:

- Kevin addressed Tim McFadden to give the updates on the Sewer Plant. Tim stated that the standby generator was up and running today and had not blown anything or any red lights. There is a 1 year warranty on those parts and labor. Village Clerk will help Tim with updating his phone so that he can use the app to monitor the WWTP for any issues so he can be notified with alerts.
- Next Kevin addressed Tim McFadden to give the update on how the meter installation was going. Tim advised they had done approximately 330 meters. Nick will come Wednesday to help get us going on the tablet. Questions were asked regarding the qualifications needed to install meters that are past the meter well (inside homes, etc.). Tim believes that they are to be installed by a licensed plumber. We will need to get letters out to those residents regarding the work that will need to be performed. If it's the newer style 25 it would be a quick change, but if it is a 15 it is not quick and would need a licensed plumber.
- Have not heard from the engineer regarding the guardrail in some time. Kevin will touch base with him.

- Tad noted that the police department received \$870 back in fines that were paid for the dog situation on Drew Court.
