Mayor Bargo:


- The County Clerks Office called and informed the village that going forward the new polling station would be at the Catlin United Methodist Church and not the Village Hall

Chief of Police


- Tad wanted to say thank you to the board for the new fence at the park, it looks nice and increases safety.
